



2020 Young Dancer and Summer Intensive Rules & Regulations

- All registration paperwork and \$300 non-refundable deposit must be submitted by **Friday, April 10, 2020**. If these items are not submitted by the above date, the student's place will be forfeited to a student who has been placed on the waiting list.
 - Any remaining tuition owed is due by **Friday, June 12, 2020**. Tuition will be automatically charged on the due date unless discussed in advance.
 - If it is necessary for a student to be absent from class, an email must be sent to the MYB office (ekfogarty@manhattanmovement.com AND v.paradiso@manhattanyouthballet.org) as soon as possible to notify the faculty.
 - Students will not be allowed to participate in class if they arrive 15 minutes after the class has begun. Students who arrive more than 15 minutes late will be asked to sit and observe.
 - Students must wear appropriate dance attire for all classes. Students not in proper attire will not be permitted to take class.
 - Students are expected to behave courteously at all times.
 - All students must request the teacher's permission to leave class for any reason.
 - The use of cigarettes, drugs, and alcohol are strictly prohibited in and around the premises of any Manhattan Youth Ballet studios, including but not limited to Manhattan Movement & Arts Center and Studio Maestro.
 - Eating and drinking, except water, is discouraged in the studios. It is REQUIRED that all students clean up any mess before leaving the studio, lobby, or hallways.
 - Manhattan Youth Ballet, Manhattan Movement & Arts Center, and Studio Maestro are not responsible for lost or stolen items. Students are to store their belongings neatly in the classroom or locked in their rented locker. Dance shoes and clothing should be marked with the student's name for easy identification.
 - Parents/guardians are not permitted to watch classes or rehearsals in the studio or from the hallways.
 - All parents/guardians & students must be announced before entering the MYB offices. Any front desk staff member can assist you in doing so.
 - Should a student become unable to attend due to injury/illness (a doctor's note is required), tuition will be pro-rated and a refund will be issued.
 - Should a student be dismissed for reasons determined by the Artistic Staff including but not limited to inappropriate/illegal behavior or excessive absences, tuition will not be refunded or credited.
 - All checks returned unpaid by our bank will incur a \$50.00 processing fee.
 - Periodically, photographers/film crews will be present to shoot Manhattan Youth Ballet classes/rehearsals. Permission for resulting photographs/film footage that include both students and/or their parents/guardians is assumed to be granted in perpetuity by them for promotional purposes on television, magazines or any other media.
 - Manhattan Youth Ballet, Manhattan Movement & Arts Center, and Studio Maestro are not liable for personal injuries or the safety of any students once they leave the premises.
